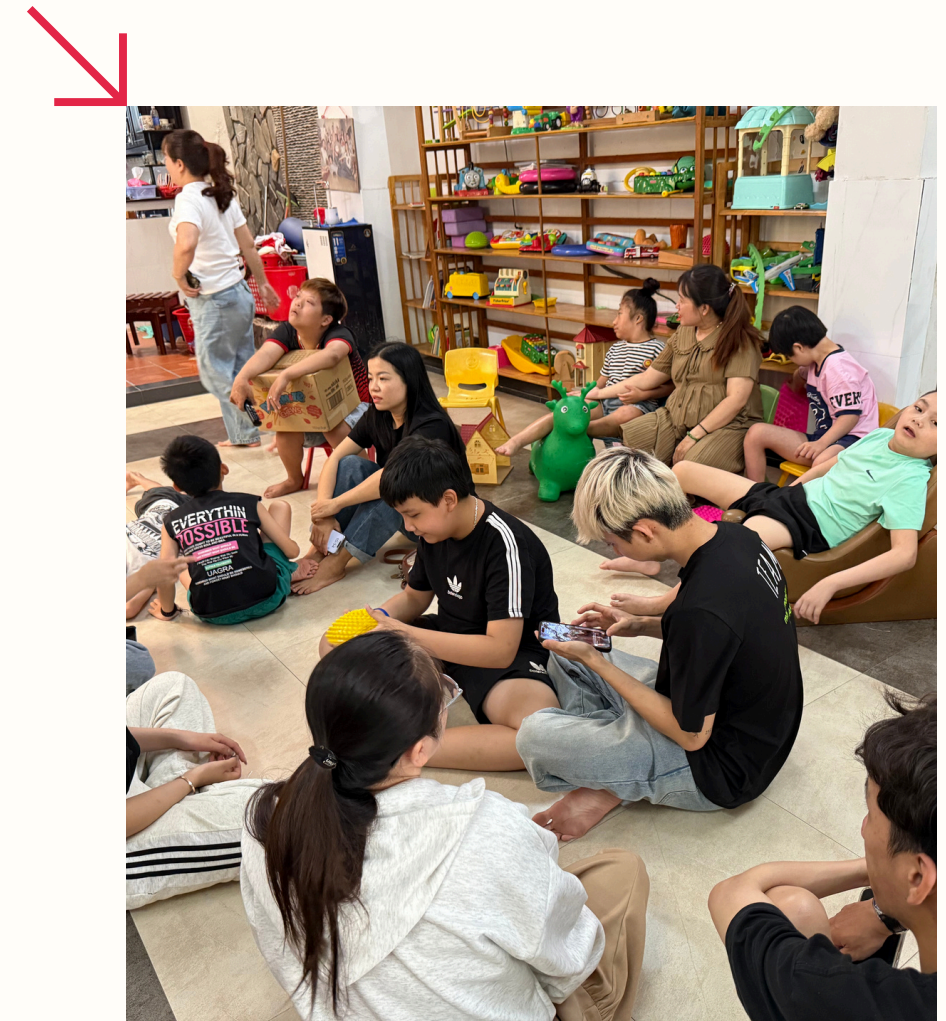
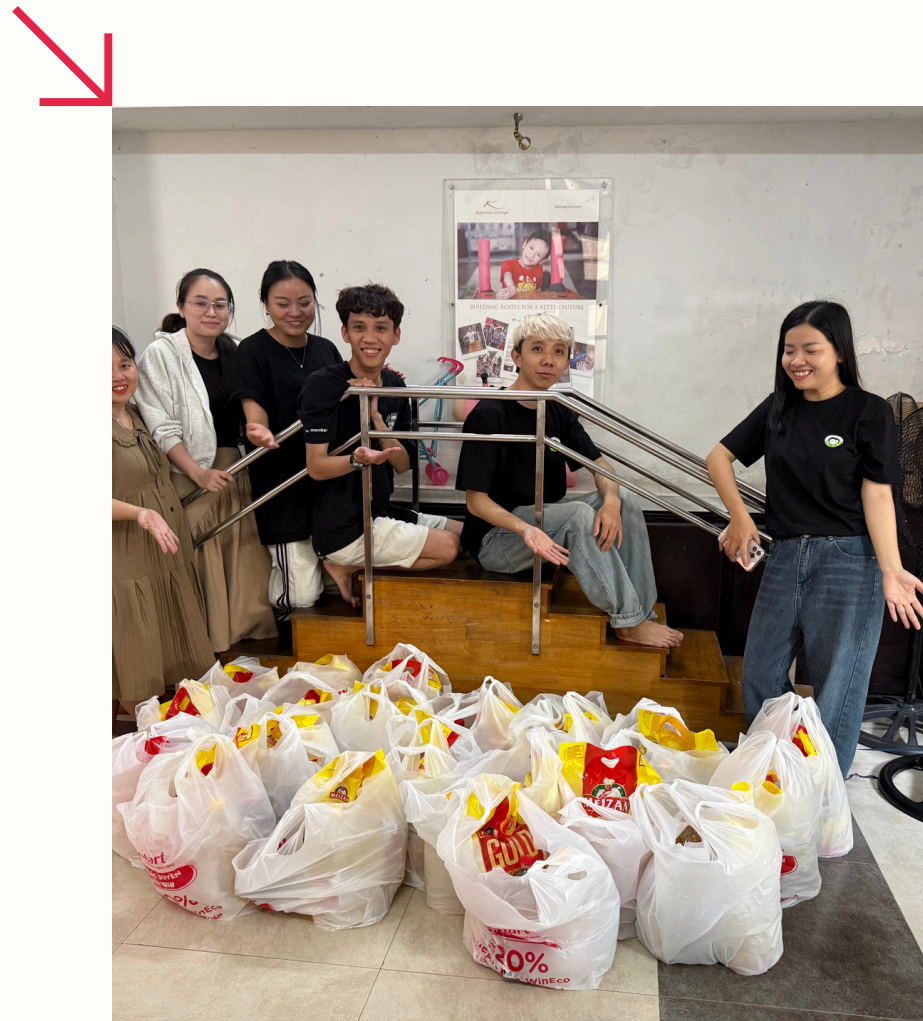
Events into Fundraisers

Catangnan Elementary School

Raised **\$427** through "Topsy Bingo," a donation box, and a Q1 pub crawl.

Siargao also donated 50% of the profits from the last Tri Island Boat Party of the quarter to their CSR tally, raising an incredible 11,550 PHP (around **\$190** USD)! Free Flow Event Donations Each Week

Children's Heritages In Action

Mad Monkey Hoi An have been contributing 70,000 VND (around \$2.3) per guest from their weekly Free Flow event every Friday. From February 27th to March 31st (end of Q1), they raised a total of 7,046,000 VND (**\$271 USD**). We provided 20 gift sets with essential items such as rice, cooking oil, and basic seasonings.



Phuket Community Kick-Off: Colouring + Playgrounds

Mad Monkey Phuket handed over 22,800 THB (approximately **\$700 USD**) from our Q1 CSR initiatives. We brought food, supplies, and spent time doing activities with the kids which was a genuinely heartwarming morning—seeing where the money is going makes it all feel even more worthwhile.

The funds we've donated so far have helped build a new play area for them (and honestly, it looks pretty cool). Last time we visited it was just an empty space, so it's amazing to see the transformation.

Tattoo for a Cause

Mad Monkey Panglao hosted a Tattoo Competition for a Cause in March, with 32 tattoo artists participating. We raised 3,200 PHP from a portion of the artists' registration fees and 5,100 PHP from walk-in ticket sales at the entrance.

Together with their regular Beer Pong for a Cause and Bingo for a Cause events each week, we have raised 27,443.00 PHP (approximately **\$445 USD**).





Siquijor Sponsors Live Band.



On May 8, 2026, during the Hudyaka sa Baybay celebration in Lazi Town, the LGU invited Mad Monkey Siquijor to sponsor a live band for the pre-fiesta celebration in honor of San Isidro Labrador.

As part of its CSR initiative, Mad Monkey Siquijor sponsored the Jazzco Band, with the band's payment equally shared between the CSR fund and Mad Monkey Siquijor.



Before the band's performance, the Mad Monkey team also organized a Trivia Night featuring special prizes for participants. The activity served as an opportunity to promote the offerings of Mad Monkey Siquijor to both locals and tourists.

Mad Monkey Phuket led the way with a new design for our donation box, which is now the standard across our portfolio in Southeast Asia.



Empowering Future Generations with AI Learning

Mad Monkey Bangkok delivered a 50,000 THB (\$1,531 USD) Q1 donation to Wat Sungwej School to fund a new air-conditioned AI learning hub. This contribution directly structures the facility by purchasing hardware, setting up English-learning software, and creating a comfortable space for kids to study and connect together.
